DEVELOPMENTS

Eastview Meadows Phase 2 - Located on the eastern border of Anoka is a 9-acre development site that is currently under construction of 20 detached townhome units targeted for empty-nesters and seniors. This new neighborhood will provide maintenance free living while maintaining the feel of single family homes.

Highland Park - The City of Anoka is in the process of completing real estate acquisitions and is making plans for the Green Haven Parkway Phase II (construction of a parkway from Garfield, where Phase 1 is completed, to Jacob Lane). Construction of the new parkway will occur in 2021. Also, the City is working on a new residential development in this same area.

The American Club – Overlooking Green Haven Golf Course, this cooperative community is exclusively designed for independent members 62+ years. It will be building along the 18th fairway of Green Haven Golf Course. It will consist of 87 homes. Construction is expected to begin early this spring.

David Weekley Homes – Located on 4th Avenue adjacent to the Rum River, construction of this 56-unit detached townhome development began. The single family residential development will be enhanced by proximity to local amenities; the Rum River, the Rum River Regional Trail, downtown Anoka, and the Northstar Commuter Rail and Anoka Station.



PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

Street Renewal Program

• Anoka's Street Renewal Program (SRP) began in the year 2000 and has reconstructed over 32% of the city's roadway system. The program was developed to reconstruct streets that are in poor condition of the bituminous surfacing, concrete curbing, and poor storm water surface drainage. This also includes replacing existing sanitary sewer, undersized water main, and storm sewer that has aged and deteriorated over time. The 2021 SRP project will begin the program in the *Swede Town* neighborhood which is bounded by Harrison Street to the north, Jackson Street to the south, 7th Avenue to the east and 4th Avenue to the west. The first area being proposed to be reconstructed includes portions of 6th Avenue (Jackson St to Harrison St), School Street (150' W of 6th Av to 7th Ave), and Van Buren Street (6th Av to 7th Av). The 2021 area includes a total of 0.44 miles at an estimated cost of \$1,851,000. The project is anticipated to begin this spring with final completion in late this fall.

COVID-19 RESPONSE

Knowing the difficult time Anoka businesses have endured during COVID-19, the City continues to provide business owners information to valuable resources, including grants, to help them navigate through this difficult time. City staff worked closely with the owners of bars and restaurants by offering a free permitting process to allow for temporary outdoor seating – even during the winter months. Staff arranged for and crews set barricades, cones, bonfire pits, continued to supply wood and kept owners informed of any changes related to the Governor's Executive Orders.






